

Testing

- NWEA MAP testing is taking place for all grades, which is a district assessment given three times per year to help us assess student learning.
- 4th & 5th graders will be taking the IAR assessment in the upcoming weeks, which is a
 nation-wide assessment given once per to assess student growth given in the spring.
 Due to the pandemic, the assessment was not taken this past spring and students are
 taking it now for the 20-21 school year. They will take this assessment again in the
 spring for the 21-22 school year.
- Students who are English Language Learners are currently taking the ACCESS test (this a nation-wide assessment to determine English language proficiency).
